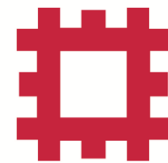

Hadrian's Wall 1900 Grants Brief

BUT

You need a company to **manage the money**.



So if you are applying by yourself, you should find a constituted **company or organisation** to be your **partner**.



This could be a charity, an organisation, a private company, a parish or community council.

There are **3 rounds** of these grants, so there are 3 chances to apply.

Round	Open from	Deadline for applications
Round 1	15th May 2022	15th June 2022
Round 2	1 July 2022	31 July 2022
Round 3	1 September 2022	30 September 2022

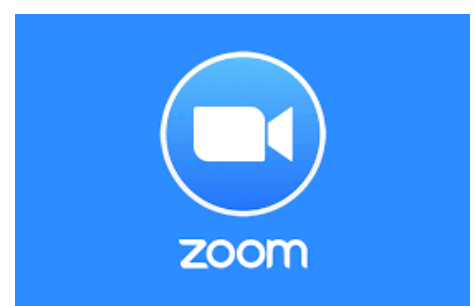
It will take around **4 weeks** to answer your application.

There will be **zoom workshops** to help with the application too.



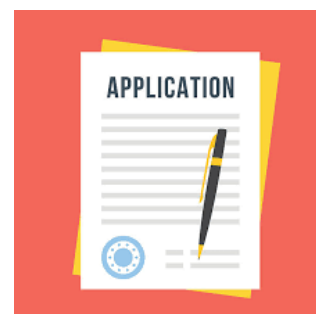

You can apply for **£250 - £5000**.

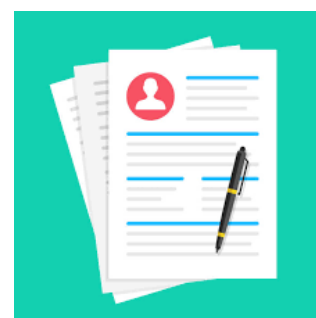


There are 2 **different application forms**
