Scissors
A glue stick
Cellotape
Felt tip pens
Your imagination

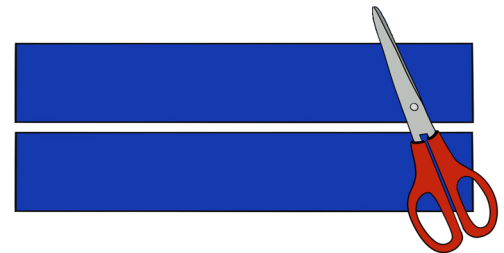

Create your own fabulous paper crowns inspired by the night sky to wear while you celebrate the Festival Of Saturnalia at home together!

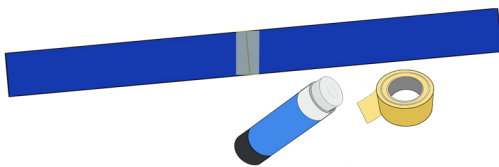

Cut out the two long strips from the crown template. These are going to become the base of your crown.



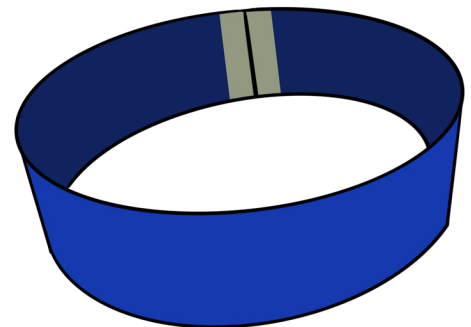

Stick these together using glue or cellotape to make one really long, thin strip.

Wrap the strip round your head to work out how big it needs to be to fit you comfortably. Tape it together. You now have the base for your crown!

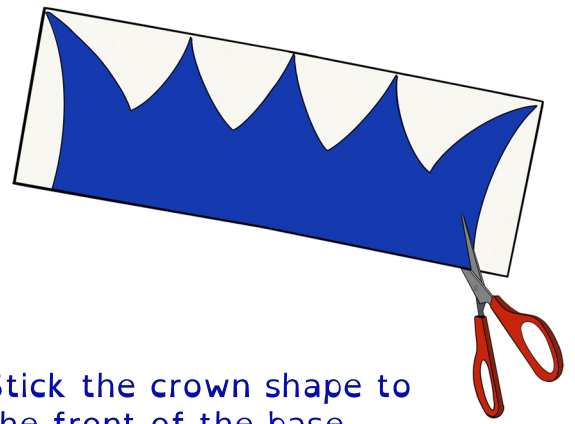
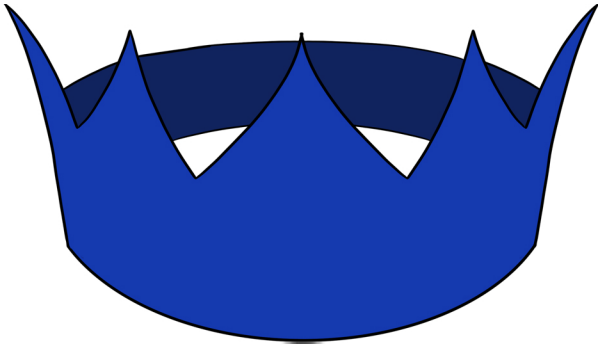

Cut out the crown shape from the template.



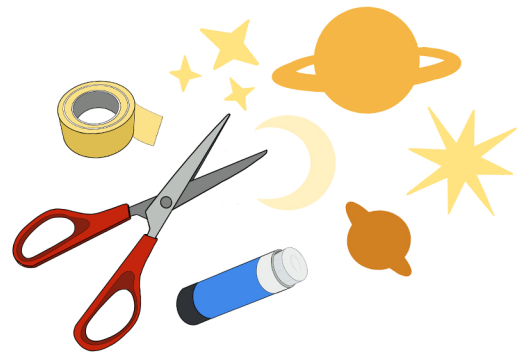

Stick the crown shape to the front of the base with glue.

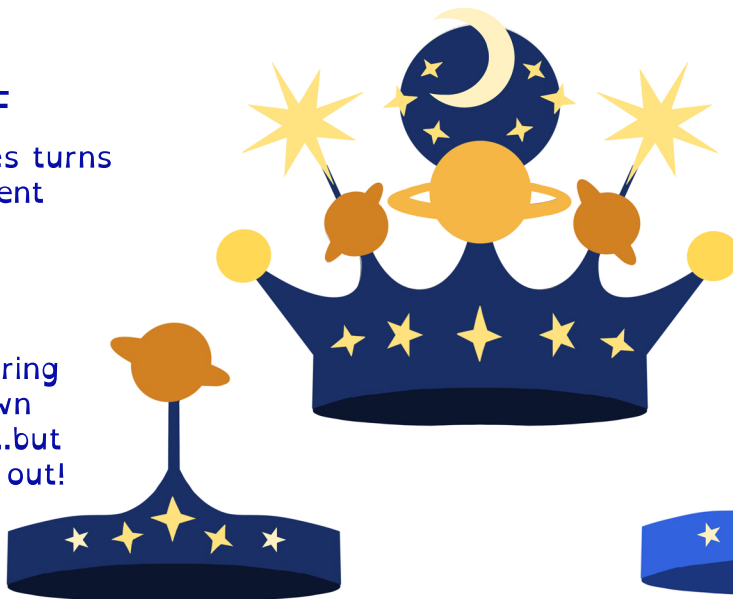
Now that you've created one celestial crown, you might want to experiment and make more using your own designs.
